Dr. Harvey's fellowship training in oculoplastic & reconstructive surgery makes him uniquely qualified to perform the following advanced procedures:

Ptosis and Dermatochalasis

Commonly referred to as 'drooping eyelid'. This condition causes eyelids to droop or excess skin to hang over the eyelashes with surgery aimed at correcting the visual field loss caused by this.

Ectropion

This condition occurs when the edges of the eyelid turn outward causing eye irritation. This can occur as a result of aging or prior surgery.

Entropion

This condition occurs when the edges of the eyelid turn inward, causing the eyelashes to rub against the surface of the eye. This can occur as the result of scar tissue or aging.

Cancer Surgery

Dr. Harvey also removes and treats eyelid tumors (cancerous or otherwise), and conducts surgical procedures related to disorders or growths on the eyebrow and forehead regions.

Oculoplastic surgeons perform cosmetic and reconstructive surgery on the eyebrows, eyelids and face. Six years of post-medical degree training is required, including two years of subspecialty training specifically focusing on plastic and reconstructive surgery of the face and how it relates to the eyes.
